What is the ND Career Builders Program? The ND Career Builders Scholarship & Loan Repayment program is a tool for businesses to recruit and retain talent in high-need occupations in ND. This unique partnership provides \$1 of state funds for each \$1 of matching funds, up to a total of \$17,000 per recipient! Individuals can receive a scholarship on the front end, loan repayment on the back-end, or both, for their commitment to the state to fill one of the high demand occupations.

- Q. Please tell us your title and role at your organization.
- **A.** I'm the Executive Director of Forward Devils Lake Corporation, we are the Economic Development organization for the City of Devils Lake and Ramsey County ND. I help facilitate and coordinate our business attraction and retention as well as workforce development efforts for the Devils Lake Region.
- Q. Tell us about your organization's involvement with the ND Career Builders Scholarship & Loan Repayment program.
- **A.** We have used the Career Builders Scholarship & Loan Repayment program from its inception. Prior to the Career Builders program being introduced we had our own regional Student loan repayment program. We have combined the programs to maximize our efforts here in the Devils Lake region.

- **A.** We are able to maximize our local community and business dollars in order to maximize our efforts of retaining and aligning our HS youth with regional businesses in careers beneficial to the youth and the region.
